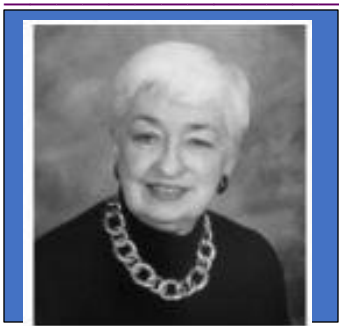

You will need is their address, phone, email, University, and degree earned. Fill out form at <https://ww2.aauw.org/grad-gift/> . (Please note: this is only national membership. **(cont.)**)

**AAUW national dues are \$49.00, of which \$46.00 is tax deductible by the individual member; \$3.00 of that national dues payment is not tax deductible because it will be used to support the AAUW Action Fund's Section 501(c)(4) activities (Lobby Corps and election-related activities). Attach is the renewal form or you can complete online.**

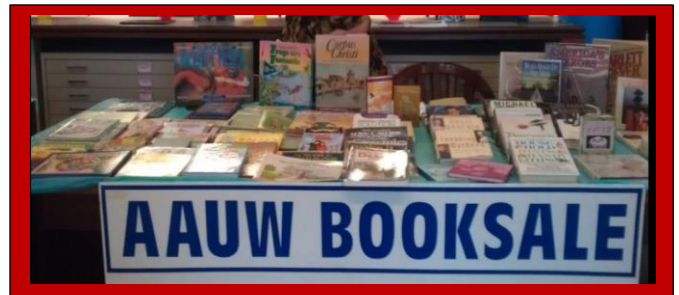
Dear AAUW,
