Because of your many efforts and hard work, AAUW continues to grow with more than 170,000 members and supporters nationwide. Our shared commitment to empowering women and girls translates into positive change across the globe.

Thanks to you, we've been able to make these advances for women and girls in 2016:

- AAUW awarded \$3.7 million in fellowships and grants to 240 scholars, researchers, and community-based programs.
- *Barriers and Bias: The Status of Women in Leadership* was published in March 2016. This highly anticipated research report reached thousands through a live-streamed launch and was featured in prestigious outlets such as *PBS' To the Contrary*, *Fortune*, *Glamour*, and the *Washington Post*.
- More than 3,600 middle school girls and parents participated in 22 one-day AAUW National Tech Savvy Program conferences and 21 weeklong Tech Trek camps across the country.
- During the 2016 legislative session, 36 states introduced equal pay bills, and 6 of those states passed new laws to address gender pay inequality.
- AAUW's Start Smart, Work Smart, student organizations, and e-student affiliate numbers all continue to grow, as does the number of AAUW college/university partner members.

We are proud of these accomplishments that you helped make possible. These efforts remind us why we are passionate members of AAUW — and we will not stop here. As women gain access to educational and economic opportunities, we must keep up our efforts to further their progress.
