Hostess Annie Huckabee treated us to Halloween goodies.

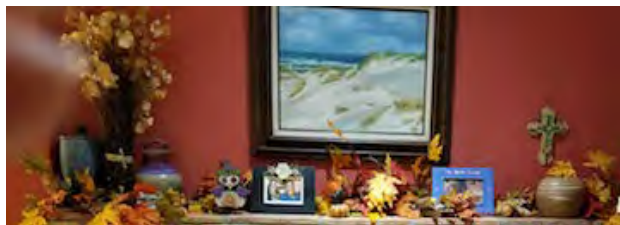

## A Fall Night with the Evening Contemporary Literature Group



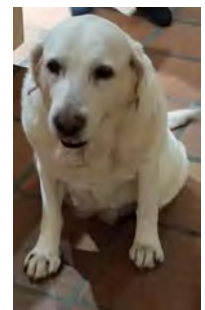
